The biggest change on this tournament is the name. The old name “Sint Tunnis Cup” referred to the district of Sint Anthonis where the games were played, but throughout the years the tournament has grown out of the borders of that district. And also in 2011 new locations will join the tournament, providing us with over 40 grass pitches. Due to these changes the name of the tournament has become. This year the number of teams has expanded to nearly 472, from different countries like Holland, Belgium, Germany, Austria, Sweden, UK, Ireland, Danmark, USA, Wales, Spain, Scotland and Italy. The age groups of the Easter Open have been expanded with the Elite Groups. These groups will host teams who play in the highest level of youth football in their countries. These teams will start there games on Friday afternoon. It will be very interesting to watch these skilful teams play there opening games. After the opening games there will be a team/coach meeting at the accommodation.
